



LITTLE LEARNERS ADVENTURE 2026 SWEEPSTAKES RULES

Sweepstakes Sponsor: Mathnasium Franchisor LLC (“Mathnasium”) (referred to herein as the “Sponsor”) is the sponsor of the Little Learners Adventure Sweepstakes 2026 (this “Sweepstakes”) described in these official sweepstakes rules (“Sweepstakes Rules”).

Eligibility: This Sweepstakes is open only to individuals (“Entrants” or “you”) who are legal residents of one of the fifty (50) states or the District of Columbia of the United States. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older.

Directors, officers, and employees of Mathnasium and Paramount and any of its subsidiary companies, or their respective professional advisors, advertising and promotional agencies, and Sweepstakes partners and prize suppliers, and immediate family members of any of them, are not eligible to participate. “Immediate family members” include spouses, siblings, parents, legal guardians, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as “in-laws,” or by current or past marriage, remarriage, adoption, co-habitation or other familial extension, and any other persons residing at the same household location, whether or not they are related.

You must provide all information requested. Incomplete or non-compliant entries will be disqualified at Sponsor’s sole discretion. Only one entry per e-mail address. Multiple entries from any person will be void. Use of any automated system or agent to submit entries is prohibited and will result in disqualification. All entries become the property of the Sponsors. In order to be named an official winner, participants must abide by these Sweepstakes Rules.

Prize Winner Notification and Requirements: The potential winner will be notified via email by July 29th, 2026, with instructions on claiming the Prize. To accept the Prize, the potential winner must follow the instructions given by the Sponsors in their notification. If a potential winner is found not to be eligible or not in compliance with these Sweepstakes rules, or if a prize notification is returned as undeliverable, a Winner does not claim the prize within three (3) business days, or the prize is rejected, the potential winner will be disqualified and the prize will be forfeited and may be awarded to an alternate winner, at the Sponsors' sole discretion.
